Taylor leaves Wingmakers

AIRBUS UK Broughton and defender Danny Taylor have parted company by mutual consent.

The 21-year-old Chester-born defender began his career with Shrewsbury Town, making his Football League debut at the age of 17.

But, despite signing a pro contract, he was released from the New Meadow a year later, signing for the Wingmakers in July 2011 and ever-present during last season's Welsh Premier campaign.

"I can confirm we have released Danny, albeit reluctantly," says Airbus director of football Andy Preece.

"Danny suffered an injury pre-season and has since struggled to gain a place in the Squad.

"I need players who want to be part of things here and be prepared to fight for a place, it's difficult but we've agreed to let Danny find first team football elsewhere and we wish him well."

Chief operating officer Stewart Roberts added: "Danny Taylor has been release by mutual consent in order to find regular football.

"On behalf of everyone I'd like to thank Danny for his commitment since he joined us from Shrewsbury Town at the start of last Season."

He added: "The adverse weather hit the second round hard this week but the potential of having two exciting Word Cup matches within a week should excite the clubs. Josh Doyle (Afan Lido) is a family friend of mine so I'll certainly be following his progress with interest but I wish all the clubs the best of luck in this new competition".

GenQuip gets Semi-pro match

The Wales Under 23 semi-professional side will meet Turkey at the GenQuip Stadium in their Final Group game of the International Challenge Trophy. The match will kick off at 6pm on Tuesday 16th October 2012. Admission will be £3 for adults, £1 for senior citizens and juveniles under 16.

The competition, played-over two seasons, helps to showcase some of the best young players in the respective countries' domestic football. Teams are grouped together and play each other once, either home or away. For this tournament, Wales beat Estonia in Tallinn 2-1 in September 2011 (Goals from Luke Bowen and Chris Jones) and then lost 4-0 to Norway in June this year.

The team is managed by Terry Boyle and a win for his side will see the young Welsh team qualify for the Semi-Finals for the first time, having participated in the competition on three occasions. The likely opponents if Wales finish second in the Group will be Russia, with the game being played out in the former Soviet State.

This announcement is a second boost for the Welsh Premier League club after it was announced yesterday that the U16 Victory Shield match against England, which will be shown live on Sky Sports, will also be played there.

Tartan Army for The Marston

Afan Lido have been working with the FAW's Andrew Howard with regards to the Airbus game on October 13th after a request from the Tartan Army, who are travelling down to watch Wales v Scotland on Friday 12th October. The Tartan Army expressed an interest in attending a Welsh Premier League game in the South Wales area after the World Cup Qualifier in Cardiff the night before.

Therefore, Lido offered a reduced entry fee (£4) for anyone who could provide proof of attendance at the World Cup match in Cardiff on October 12th (regardless of their Nationality).

Contact was then made by the 'Doonhamers Tartan Army' regarding facilities and hospitality and the outcome is that they are attending and sponsoring the Airbus game.

Challenge Trophy squad announced



Wales Semi-Pro Manager Terry Boyle has called up two uncapped players for the forthcoming International Challenge Trophy Match against Turkey, which will be played at Port Talbot Town's GenQuip Stadium on Tuesday 16th October 2012. (6:00pm K.O)

The uncapped duo are both Welsh Premier League players with Llanelli's midfielder Ashley Evans being named in the eighteen for the first time, having previously been on stand-by. The other new face in Boyle's squad is David Brooks of Port Talbot Town who

has enjoyed an excellent start to the season. The wide attacking-midfielder previously played for Welsh League minnows Bridgend Street, before Port Talbot boss Mark Jones brought him into the Welsh Premier in August 2010.

There are also recalls for full-backs Mike Pearson and Curtis McDonald. Injury kept Llandudno-based Barrow right-back Pearson out of June's defeat in Norway and McDonald has re-captured his form since a summer move to Conference North leaders Brackley.

Steve Cann proved his fitness yesterday in Carmarthen's goal following a dislocated shoulder and he will continue a four-year battle for the number 1 shirt with Bangor City's Lee Idzi. The team is captained by TNS defender Kai Edwards, who is one of a quartet of Saints players named, along with midfielders Chris Jones and Aeron Edwards and striker Alex Darlington.

The four players to miss out from the Norway match, which was lost 4-0, are Richie Dorman, Jack Mackreth, Craig Moses and Toby Jones and they are all named on stand-by.
